In July 2023, the [UNCITRAL Code of Conduct for Arbitrators in International Investment Dispute Resolution](#) was adopted, the draft of which was prepared by UNCITRAL's Working Group III on ISDS reform. In December 2023, the United Nations General Assembly adopted a resolution recommending the use of the Code by arbitrators, former arbitrators, candidates, disputing parties, and administering institutions, and recommending governments involved in the negotiation of international investment instruments to make reference to the Code.
